SNOW EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSING: WALK is the official radio station of WSCS. Channel 12 is the official TV channel. WALK is at 1370 on the AM dial and 97.5 on the FM dial or their websites are www.walkradio.com and for Channel 12 www.news12.com. Those families that have signed up for email notification will be notified by email. In the event of winter storms causing hazardous driving conditions, notification of school closing will be broadcast over this station and channel. **Please DO NOT call the school.** If the Sayville Public Schools close, WSCS automatically closes. However, we reserve the right to close even if Sayville opens. Listen to the radio or TV to be sure. If your district closes and WSCS does not close, transportation will **not** be provided by your district; and we ask you to make every effort to bring your children to school.

In case of early dismissal, the school will make every effort to contact your home prior to releasing children. **You should prepare a plan NOW for your children in case of an early dismissal caused by adverse weather conditions. The buses cannot be detained for any period of time, so set up a plan instructing your children where to go in the event you are not home.** If we do close early WALK and TV channel 12 will be asked to broadcast that information.

CHAPEL OFFERING: Our December offering of \$131.28 went to Long Island Youth Mentoring. Our January offering will be for the WSCS Mission Team. A group of teachers will take 20 7th & 8th graders and previous trip alumni to Huntington, NY during winter recess.
